
Navigation Limits - 4

East Coast of Canada and U.S.A. (east of 95 degrees of longitude west):

- a) Canadian eastern coastal waters south of 52nd degrees latitude north but no farther than 160 km (100 miles) offshore;
- b) All United States inland waters north of 40th degrees north latitude; and
- c) United States eastern coastal waters north of 40th degrees north latitude but no farther than 160 km (100 miles) offshore;

West Coast of Canada and U.S.A.:

- a) All Canadian Inland waters except the Fraser River above the junction of the Sumas River; and
- b) Coastal waters within the area bounded by lines drawn between Cape Flattery (U.S.A.) and Owen Point (Canada) to the Southwest of Vancouver Island, Cape Sutil and Mexicana Point and Cape James and Allison Harbour to the Northwest of Vancouver Island.

N.B.: Other areas of navigation may be insured provided they are stipulated on the Declarations Page.
